Background

- » Preventive medical check-up at no charges since 1974
 - » For all 18+
 - » At the general physician and special examination centers
- » 2005: Re-design of the screening-programme
 - » Consider advancements in medicine ("state-of-the-art")
 - » Evidence-based

» Goals

- » Early detection of main diseases like cancer, diabetes, cardio-vascular diseases,...
- » Promotion of a healthy life-style (smoking, alcohol, diet, physical activity



Components of the medical Checkup

- » Questionnaire for the patient (Yes/No)
 - » Topics with a relation to oral health, e.g. smoking, diabetes
 - » Bleeding (when cleaning or eating) or does the tissue feel swollen
 - » loss of tissue (do you think your teeth got longer or the space between teeth got bigger)
 - » In case of a partial prostheses did the fit change
 - » Problems with bad breath
- » Inspection of the oral cavity by GP
 - » Information material and workshops for general physicians (partly compulsory)
- » 2 Interventions, depending on "risk-assessment"
 - » Instruction on cleaning of teeth and interdentium
 - » Referral to a "periodontal oriented dentist"
- » Recommended interval for screening: every 6 yrs




Evaluation - some results

- » Evaluation methods:
 - » Questionnaire for participants
 - » Questionnaire for general physians
 - » Monitoring of diagnostic findings (pseudonymisiert)
 - » Analysis of other (outcome-)data from sickfunds
 - » Evidence based Health Care Analysis
- » Participation rate for VUneu:
 - » 2010: 12,5 % of the entitled population took part (women: 12,9 %; men: 12,0 %)
 - » Mean age of participants: 50 years
 - » 2002–2010: positive trend in participation

Patients 'questionnaire

» Did the GP talk with you about the following topics?





GP questionnaire

» General physicians attitude regarding information/training


Because of my experience and my competencies I consider a further training not necessary (N=1.413)

A further training session is not necessary, because self-study is more efficient with respect to special contents of the screening-programme (N=1.377)

The new screening programme requires techniques which can't be acquired in trainings (e.g. communication skills, counceling (N=1.340)

Trainings for other topics are more important (N=1.346)

Overall, I consider myself adequately trained for the implementation of the new screening programme (N=1.385)






Monitoring of diagnostic findings

Analysis of other data from sickfunds

» Mean number of contacts with medics



On average, every Austrian insured visits the dentist **once every 9 months**.

Those, participating at VU neu, visit the dentist **0.8 times every 9 months**



Evidence based Health Care Analysis

- » Search period Nov 08 Aug 09
- » Re "dental and periodontal disease" and "screening":
 - » U.S. Preventive Services Task Force:
 - » "inactive topic"; no new recommendations or adaptions of recommendations since 1996
 - » UK National Screening Committee:
 - » No up-to-date recommendations
 - » Additional research via PubMed
 - » "... no final conclusion to the validity of the instrument (of self reported periodontal disease) can be drawn."
- → No "high-grade" evidence for periodontal screening at the GP´s office
- → "decision to include it in VU neu is not reproducible"



Statements by professional societies in Austria

- » Austrian Society for general and family medicine
 - » Neither homogenous recommendations for teeth cleaning nor nationwide supply of professional cleaning
 - » Dentistry is now a separate medical discipline with its own curriculum. Education and further training of non-dentists can therefore not ensure enough competence necessary for dental diagnosis.
 - » Proposal to replace "questionnaire plus inspection" through a general recommendation to visit the dentist regularly
- » Austrian Society for Periodontology
 - » Inspection of the oral cavity can only be done by a dentist
 - » Recommends only questions for patients; if one is answered yes → referral to a dentist
